All club members are expected to comply with the following 'Code of Conduct' guidelines while taking part in any club activities. Similarly, it is expected that all members of Bury and Elton ASC including swimmers, teachers/ coaches, volunteers, and parents adhere to the following:

ARRIVE ON TIME

All swimmers should arrive 10 minutes before the start time of each session.

EQUIPMENT

Each swimmer should have their own goggles, swim caps, drinks bottles, boards, fins etc. These should be organised before the start of each practice session. Swimmers should also use the lavatory before each practice session.

WORK HARD

Complete the work required – disruption of practice by a swimmer will be grounds for removal from the session. Inform your teacher/coach if you are feeling unwell or you have a medical problem.

RESPECT

Show respect and care for the property of others and pay others respect including all club coaches and teachers. Be polite to everyone; show team spirit and good sportsmanship at ALL times.

PROUD OF YOUR CLUB

Be proud of yourself and of the club's achievements. Support your club whenever and wherever possible.

BULLYING

Any form of bullying will not be tolerated.

DRUGS

Swimmers must not drink alcohol or use tobacco products or illegal drugs or substances banned by British Swimming .
